Recent Grants

Recent grants awarded from the Birketts Cambridgeshire Fund include:

- Cambridgeshire County Council was given £1,000 to help young people homeless or at risk of becoming homeless to secure accommodation and basic food essentials.
- Mind Cambridgeshire was awarded a grant of £900 to offer a facilitated group programme addressing the issues of anger.
- Cambridge & Ely Child Contact Centres received £650 to continue existing work, to pay the coordinator's salary and to bring their website up to date.
- Ormiston Children and Families Trust were awarded £780 to purchase resources for a project to help children living in Cambridgeshire to manage the effects of a parent going into prison.
