The D and J Lloyd Community First Fund offer grants to support voluntary and community groups working in Cambridgeshire to:

1. **Provide support and relief** to those that are in need, in particular those suffering financial hardship, illness, social isolation or homelessness or negative effects of old age.
2. **Promote the arts**, in particular but not exclusively work to help those at a disadvantage to take part in arts activities.
3. **Protect the environment** and or sites or buildings of historic or architectural importance.
4. **Promote learning, skills development and education** (excluding areas of statutory responsibility) to those that are marginalized or excluded from society.

Recent Awards

Recent grant awards include:

St Paul's Church and Community Centre were awarded a grant to run a community Arts Festival.

Rowan Humberstone Ltd received a grant to set up a screen printing room where the disabled students can be creative and develop a specialised skill-set.

Wintercomfort was awarded a grant towards the cost of providing washing and laundry facilities for one year for isolated and marginalised members of the community.
